

# English Paper Piecing

Here is a list of supplies you need for English paper piecing a project. The optional items are helpful, but necessary for this class. Note: this class is not Foundation Paper Piecing.

---

## BRING TO CLASS:

- 1. Pattern (Print on card stock, mailers, file folders, etc. if possible. The goal is something slightly thicker than copy paper. Copy paper is fine.)
- 2. **BEFORE CLASS, CUT OUT SEVERAL SHAPES TO WORK WITH FROM THE TEMPLATE**
- 3. Pen & Paper for note taking
- 4. One piece of scrap paper to use with gluestick.
- 5. Water soluble glue stick
  - a. Sewline type (water soluble) gluestick, <https://geni.us/lwE2yy3> (amazon)
  - b. or Purple glue stick <https://geni.us/jTKR> (amazon)
- 6. Fabric choices, 2-8 or more so you can change your mind. Look at your scraps first! The fabric size should be 1/4"-3/8" larger all the way around your shapes.
- 7. Ruler
- 8. Thread (50-100 weight, cotton or polyester) or InvisiFil <https://geni.us/HutR2>
- 9. Hand Sewing Needles <https://geni.us/p0sAO>
- 10. Scissors, snips

## OPTIONAL:

- 1. 1/4" masking tape/washi tape (for flatback stitch)
- 2. EPP Punch <https://geni.us/zi6Ajk>
